Dear Mr. Hale:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) has reviewed Public Service Company of New Mexico's (PNM's) request for a Class 1 permit modification to the above-referenced Permit, submitted by letter with draft well logs from John Hale to Carl Will dated October 29, 1999, and by letter with final well logs from John Hale to Carl Will dated February 17, 2000.

PNM proposes the following Permit modification:

- 1) addition of extraction well PSMW-EW2, located approximately 34 feet north of PSMW-10;
- 2) addition of extraction well PSMW-EW3, located approximately 39 feet north of PSMW-22.

HRMB has determined that the proposed changes are Class 1 modifications, as defined at 20

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NMAC 4.1.900 (incorporating 40 CFR. §270.42).

The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Fees Regulations, at 20 NMAC 4.2, require assessment of fees for permit modifications. The fee for a Class I modification under 20 NMAC 4.2.206., Table 2.4, is one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00). HRMB will issue an invoice to you under a separate letter. Payment is due within 60 days from the date that you receive the invoice. The modification request will be processed after HRMB receipt of the fee.

If you request an extension to the sixty-day due date, that extension request must be received by HRMB no later than 14 days prior to the end of the sixty-day period. If you disagree with the fee assessed you may file an administrative appeal in accordance with 20 NMAC 4.2.302.1.
