Dear Mr. Hale:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed the subject document and the Public Service Company of New Mexico's January 31, 2005 response to NMED's Notice of Deficiency dated September 4, 2003. NMED has determined that the Class 3 permit modification request is administratively complete and that the seven (7) solid waste management units (SWMU's) that are the subject of this modification request appear to be suitable for No Further Action. The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Fee Regulations 20.4.2 NMAC require assessment of fees when administrative review of a document is complete. The Hazardous Waste Bureau will issue an invoice under separate letter. Payment is due within 60 days from the day you receive the invoice.

Should you request an extension of the sixty-day period, the request must be received by NMED within a minimum of fourteen (14) calendar days prior to the end of the sixty-day period. Should you disagree with the fee assessed you may file an Administrative Appeal under the provisions of 20.4.2.302.1 NMAC.
