Dear Mr. Sherman:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has completed its administrative review of the permit modification request submitted by Philips Semiconductors. This modification request was submitted to NMED on September 16, 1992. Some revisions to the modification were requested at your meeting with NMED staff at Philips in Albuquerque on August 30, 1993.

This permit modification request, with revisions as requested, has been determined to be administratively complete. A determination of completeness does not preclude NMED from requesting additional information from Philips to clarify, modify, or supplement previously submitted material. Requests for such additional information will not render this modification request incomplete.

Upon determination of administrative completeness, the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Fee Regulations (HWFR-1), promulgated under authority of the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act (§74-4-1 et seq., NMSA 1978, as amended, 1989), require assessment of a permit fee.

The permit modification has been determined to be a Class I (minor) modification, pursuant to the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (HWMR-7), Part IX. The fee assessment for a Class I modification is \$1,000 (HWFR-1, §206.B.1).



This fee must be paid within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter. Failure to pay the fee will result in the issuance of a compliance order or in permit modification denial.

Upon receipt of the permit modification fee, review of the permit modification for technical adequacy will be completed. NMED plans to complete the technical review by December 30, 1993.
