Dear Mr. Garcia:

Philips Semiconductors (Philips) located at 9201 Pan American Fwy N.E. in Albuquerque currently operates a hazardous waste storage facility under EPA ID# NMD000709782. The storage areas consist of two containerized waste storage areas, two 5000-gallon waste acid tanks, and one 5000-gallon solvent waste tank.

Our current permit expires April 1, 1996, and rather than renewing the permit, we will begin to operate as a 90-day generator. As such, this letter is to give you 180 days notice of the beginning of closure of the storage areas. Closure should begin December 23, 1995, and will not commence before December 14. Closure will be completed before our permit expires April 1, 1996.

An outside consultant will be retained to oversee closure implementation. Once the consultant has been chosen we will notify you. If you have any questions, please contact me at (505) 822-7634.
