SUBJ.: Notification of modification of RCRA permit (HWA module) for Philips Semiconductors.

Thank you for your Feb. 27, 1996, memo subject as above. Stephanie Kruse called me about this last week and we briefly discussed the site. At this time we do not have a specific concern about this site.

In general, SWQB's main concern with most SWMU's involves containment of any contaminated surface (storm water) runoff and/or contaminated leachate that may leak to a surface watercourse. It is important that appropriate Best Management Practices (BMPs) (e.g., control of runoff/runoff) be implemented as quickly as possible if necessary. Since these investigations/cleanups may take a long time, all phases of remediation need to be considered. Appropriate BMPs for each phase may be different.

Since there does not seem to be a threat to surface water from this site at this time we do not wish to actively participate. However, if any of the above concerns are subsequently identified, or if you have any questions, please contact me at 827-2827.
