**RE: PHILIPS SEMICONDUCTORS ADJACENT RCRA FACILITIES**

A site reconnaissance of the surrounding property owners to Philips Semiconductors' property at 9201 Pan American Freeway, N.E., Albuquerque, NM on Monday, 15 April 1996 (during the quarterly groundwater sampling of Philips four monitoring wells) revealed the following two neighboring facilities to the west.

Honeywell, Inc. @ 9201 San Mateo Blvd., N.E., is directly west of Philips' employee parking area, across San Mateo Blvd. from the northwest corner of Philips' property. Honeywell, Inc. is a RCRA large quantity generator with a less than 90 day waste storage area onsite. The Honeywell facility is immediately to the south of the former City of Albuquerque's Nazareth Landfill, located to the southwest of the intersection of San Mateo Blvd. and San Diego.

Across (North of) San Diego from Honeywell, Inc. is Sumitomo Sitix Silicon, Inc. @ 9401 San Mateo Blvd., N.E. Sumitomo notified NMED, HRMB in July of 1994 that they were a small quantity generator (< 100 kg/mo). No other contact between NMED, HRMB and this facility was found in the file. Sumitomo's facility lies just north of the Nazareth Landfill.
