As we discussed on the phone last week, I have contacted Mr. David Neleigh with the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 6, with a request to provide NMED with assistance in the review of Corrective Action documents for Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU) #8, the Coronado Municipal Landfill. Mr. Neleigh's staff will provide technical and regulatory review of the documents and recommend action to NMED based on the review. HRMB will notify you of an official regulatory position taken after receiving EPA's comments based on the review. This SWMU is located on your property and is regulated under the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments (HSWA) module of your RCRA permit No. NMD000709782-1.

Mr. Neleigh has asked Ms. Nancy Morlock to undertake this task and see it through to completion. Ms. Morlock can be contacted at 214/665-6650.

Documents submitted to date, according to our files, include the RCRA Facility Investigation Work Plan, dated June 14, 1996, and subsequent Quarterly Reports. Appropriate files, along with correspondence already received in this office, will be transmitted to Ms. Morlock.
