Dear Mr. Cochran:

The RCRA Permits Management Program (RPMP) has completed the Administrative Completeness review of the Request for Modification of Sampling Requirements in the HSWA module of the Philips Semiconductor permit submitted to NMED/HRMB in June 1999. **The document has been determined to be administratively complete and a fee of \$1,000 is assessed for continued review and processing of this document.**

Payment is due within sixty (60) days of your receipt of this letter. Should the return receipt be sent back to us without a date the fees are due sixty (60) days from the date of this letter. Payment should be made by certified check or money order payable to the New Mexico Environment Department Hazardous Waste Permits Fund 339. Should you need to request an extension of the sixty (60) day period the request must be received by the RPMP a minimum of fourteen (14) calendar days prior to the end of the sixty (60) day period. This fourteen (14) day period will be necessary to ensure that the facility receives written approval prior to the expiration of the sixty (60) day payment period.

Should you disagree with the fee assessed you may file an administrative appeal under the provisions of 20 NMAC 4.2.302.1.
