
The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) is in receipt of your January 5, 2007, letter requesting cancellation of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Identification Number for the former Philips Semiconductors, Inc. (PSC), located in Albuquerque, New Mexico. On February 28, 2006, NMED issued its final decision granting PSC's No Further Action petition for SWMU #8, the former Coronado Municipal Landfill. This action subsequently terminated PSC's Hazardous Waste Facility Permit.

U.S. EPA identification numbers are permanently assigned to property locations and are not cancelled. The activities associated with the PSC EPA Identification Number are provided for in the U.S. EPA RCRA Information System (RCRIS). RCRIS indicates that the activities at the location have been completed and no longer require further action.
