The New Mexico Environmental Improvement Division (EID) has completed an administrative review of Safety Kleen's permit application. The complete permit application is considered to consist of Appendices A, B, C, D, E, F, and H from the September 14, 1987 document; revisions of Appendices C, E, F and H from the November 11, 1989 document; the text and a complete revision of Appendix G from the May 4, 1990 document.

The following appendix revisions have been noted:

APPENDIX C

- 1) The 'Site Plan' submitted in 1987 has been revised with the diagram #D10485 submitted in 1989.
- 2) A Topo map with 1": 80' scale was added in 1989.

APPENDIX E

- 1) The 'Facility Inspection Record and Procedure' forms submitted in 1987 have been revised with 'Tank, Drum Storage, and Emergency Equipment Inspection' forms submitted in 1989.
- 2) The 'Emergency Equipment List' submitted in 1987 was revised in 1989.

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- 3) The 'Typical Underground Tank Installation Details' submitted in 1987 have been revised in 1989 with diagrams #D13617, #D13618, and #D13619 (Double Wall Plasteel Tank for Secondary Containment).

APPENDIX F

- 1) The 'Emergency Information' submitted in 1987 was revised in 1989.
- 2) Certified mail receipts for letters sent to the Albuquerque Fire and Police Departments and hospitals have been included in 1989.
- 3) A copy of a letter from the Albuquerque Emergency Response Department accepting the contingency plan and requesting additional information has been included in 1989.
- 4) The Site Plan Evacuation Route was included in 1989.

APPENDIX G

- 1) Appendix G has been substituted in its entirety with Appendix G from the May 4, 1990 document.

APPENDIX H

- 1) Appendix H was revised in 1989 except for the Closure Schedule, a 1986 Annual Report, and a note concerning liability insurance.

The application addresses four hazardous waste units:

- (1) An underground hazardous waste storage tank not yet installed
- (2) A container storage unit--East Warehouse, currently in use
- (3) A container storage unit--West Warehouse, not yet in use for hazardous waste storage
- (4) A container storage unit--metal shed for paint waste, not yet constructed.

EID has completed its administrative review of the permit application for the storage tank and storage container units and found it administratively complete in accordance with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations, as amended 1989, Part IX, 40 CFR Section 270.10(c). Technical review may begin upon receipt of the permit fees. The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Fee Regulations require the assessment of the permit fees when

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the Permit Application is declared administratively complete. The fee for Safety Kleen's Albuquerque service center is \$31,000.00. The statement and worksheet are enclosed. Please make the check payable to the state of New Mexico. The fee is due within 30 days and failure to render payment of fees will result in permit denial.
