
Dear Concerned Citizen.

The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Bureau will hold two public informational meetings to provide an opportunity for the public to comment on a hazardous waste storage permit application from the Safety-Kleen, Albuquerque service center. The meetings will be held at 3:30 and 6:00 p.m., Thursday, September 27, 1990 at the McKinley Middle School, 4500 Comanche N.E. in Albuquerque.

Safety Kleen Corporation operates a commercial hazardous waste storage facility under interim status at 2720 Girard N.E. in Albuquerque. Safety-Kleen is a commercial service-oriented company whose customers are primarily engaged in automotive repair, industrial maintenance and dry cleaning. The listed hazardous wastes which are stored at the facility include parts cleaner solvent, dry cleaner solvent, and paint waste. The waste is accumulated in an underground storage tank and three container storage units. Total hazardous waste storage capacity will be 19,140 gallons. These wastes are shipped to one of seven Safety-Kleen recycling centers or to an independent reclaimer and are then returned to the customers as usable product.
