Dear Ms. Toossi and Mr. Dolk:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED, the Department) has reviewed the permit modification request submitted by Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc., Albuquerque Service Center (the Permittee, the Facility) received by email on April 2, 2018. The Permittee stated that Table D.1 of the Permit (Contingency Plan), was not current. The request was also discussed in an April 18, 2018 meeting between the Permittee and the Hazardous Waste Bureau. During the meeting, the Permittee requested that changes to be made to Permit Attachment 7 (Contingency Plan), to update the emergency contact list.

In the request, the Permittee proposed updating Table D.1 by replacing Mr. Angel Chavez, formerly the Alternate Emergency Coordinator, with Ms. Elizabeth Thomas, who is currently the Lead Material Handler.

Following review of the Permit Modification proposal, NMED has determined that it is a Class 1 Permit Modification not requiring Agency approval.

Since the Permit Modification is a self-implementing change that does not require approval from

Ms. Toossi and Mr. Dolk
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NMED, the Permittee must send out a notice of the modification request to all persons on the facility mailing list previously received from the Department. The Permittee must also incorporate the attached Emergency Coordinator list into its current permit upon receipt of this letter.

Further, the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Fee Regulations 20.4.2 NMAC require assessment of fees when administrative review of a document is complete. NMED has attached an invoice to this letter. Payment of the fees is due within sixty (60) calendar days from the date that you receive the invoice.

If payment is by check, then you must provide the invoice number on the check. If payment is transmitted electronically, then you must submit a letter to Mr. Brian Holton, NMED Hazardous Waste Bureau, indicating the invoice number, payment amount, and the assessed activity prior to transferring funds.

Should the Permittees need to request an extension of the sixty-day period the request must be submitted at least seven days prior to the end of the sixty-day period. Should the Permittees disagree with the fee assessed you may file an Administrative Appeal under the provisions of 20.4.2.302 NMAC.
