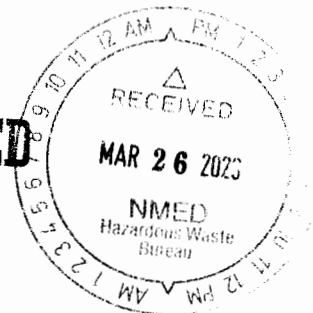

This letter is a notification of an un-manifested waste identified when Used Oil collected in railcar UTLX660112 was tested for Polychlorinated Biphenyls upon arrival at the Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. East Chicago Re-refinery. Find below the following information concerning the correction of the manifests:



6. The certification signed by the owner or operator of the facility or his authorized representative: *See Certification on the Bill of Ladings.*
7. Brief explanation of why the waste was un-manifested: *The material was originally shipped as Used Oil for recycling. All TSCA equipment at San Juan Generating Station had been retro-filled and were identified as no longer containing TSCA regulated PCBs. Pre-project sampling of the tanks confirmed this. During the project one 6,000-gallon tank was refilled with oil which was supposed to come from the same source as the rest of the oil. Upon receipt of the railcar at the Safety-Kleen East Chicago site a sample pulled from the railcar was found to contain 28 ppm of PCBs. Generator retain samples from each day's shipments were then tested. All shipments came in < 2 ppm with the exception of the Generator retain sample taken on 12-17-19 which accounted for two loads and Generator retain sample taken on 12-18-19 which accounted for one 3000-gallon load. The results for these shipments were 43 ppm and 145 ppm, respectively. Subsequent shipments into this railcar showed < 2 ppm PCBs. As TSCA regulated PCBs the oil should have been sent on a Uniform Hazardous Waste Manifest.*
8. The disposition made of the unmanifested waste by the commercial storage or disposal facility, including: *The railcar was redirected from Safety-Kleen East Chicago to the Clean Harbors Clive rail site and will then be transferred to the Clean Harbors Aragonite incinerator for TSCA destruction. Once the manifest has been received and signed by the Clean Harbors Clive rail site, a signed copy of the manifest will be provided to Region 6. The railcar will be deconned at the Clean Harbors Clive, UT site and the rinse materials sent to Clean Harbors Aragonite for destruction as well.*
9. If the waste was stored or disposed by that facility, was the generator identified and was a manifest subsequently supplied: *At the point we identified the PCB issue Safety-Kleen created the manifest 004895847SKS to properly document the shipment for its alternate destination. A copy of manifest 004895847SKS has been attached to this email. Due to shipping by rail and having to use an alternate TSDf the shipment has not arrived within 45 days and is still in transit. No manifest was created for the inbound shipments from PNM to Safety-Kleen's Albuquerque as these shipments were already terminated. The tanker truck went directly from PNM to the Safety-Kleen Albuquerque site, then transferred to the rail site and on to The Safety-Kleen East Chicago Re-Refinery. The oil was never offloaded at Safety-Kleen Albuquerque.*

The tanker truck used for all the Power New Mexico shipments has been triple rinsed with 10% of its maximum volume with diesel fuel. The final rinse PCB level was found to be < 2 ppm. The tote of rinseate will be shipped to the Clean Harbors Deer Park incinerator for destruction.

Additional Terms and Conditions

I. Definition of Terms

When used in this document, the following terms shall have the meanings given below:

Used Oil means any oil that has been refined from crude oil, or any synthetic oil, that has been used and as a result of such use is contaminated by physical or chemical impurities. As used herein, Used Oil includes oil generated by individuals through the maintenance of their personal vehicles (household do-it-yourselfer used oil). Petroleum hydrocarbons used as solvents are specifically excluded from the definition of Used Oil.

Nonhazardous Wastes include spent materials that are not listed in 40 CFR Part 261 Subpart D, and do not exhibit any of the characteristics included in 40 CFR Part 261 Subpart C. Mixtures of Used Oils and Nonhazardous Wastes are classified and managed as Used Oils.

Vehicle Fluids are limited to Used Oils (including hydraulic oils and transmission oils), nonhazardous antifreeze, and oily waters originating from the maintenance of vehicles, and household do-it-yourselfer used oil. The term vehicle as used herein includes, but is not limited to automobiles, buses, trucks, tractors, aircraft and similar type machines utilizing internal combustion engines.

Non-Vehicle Fluids include all Used Oils and Nonhazardous Wastes that are not classified as Vehicle Fluids. Non-Vehicle Fluids include, but are not limited to cutting oils, hydraulic fluids, compressor oils, metal working oils, and other nonhazardous aqueous waste streams.

Nonconforming Wastes include: 1) materials provided to Safety-Kleen which have been mixed, combined, or otherwise blended with materials containing regulated concentrations of polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs); 2) materials provided to Safety-Kleen which have been mixed, combined, or otherwise blended with materials regulated as hazardous wastes under applicable laws, including but not limited to 40 CFR Part 261; and 3) materials provided to Safety-Kleen that exhibit chemical or physical characteristics which deviate from the analytical results obtained from analysis of Customer's prequalification sample previously obtained by or provided to Safety-Kleen.

CESQG, conditionally exempt small quantity generator. Customer is a CESQG if he generates no more than 100 kilograms of hazardous wastes in a given calendar month. In the event that Customer is located in a state that has adopted a more stringent definition, then the state definition shall apply.

SQG, small quantity generator. Customer is a SQG if he generates more than 100 kilograms but less than 1000 kilograms of hazardous wastes in a given calendar month. In the event that Customer is located in a state that has adopted a more stringent definition, then the state definition shall apply.

LQG, large quantity generator. Customer is a LQG if he generates more than 1000 kilograms of hazardous wastes in a given calendar month. In the event that Customer is located in a state that has adopted a more stringent definition, then the state definition shall apply.

Intermediate Facility refers to the facility responsible for providing collection services to the Customer, and does not necessarily refer to the final destination of the shipment, nor to a facility which will treat, process or store the material.

II. Safety-Kleen's Oil Service

Safety-Kleen's Oil Service includes the collection, transportation, and recycling or treatment of Used Oils and Nonhazardous Wastes in accordance with the requirements of 40 CFR Part 279 and applicable solid waste regulations. Customer is responsible for properly classifying his waste streams as Used Oil or Nonhazardous Wastes in accordance with the provisions of 40 CFR 262.11 and applicable state laws. Safety-Kleen will collect and transport the materials, based on Customer's representation of the materials, in accordance with all applicable local, state, and federal regulations, and may use third party transporters or rail services to transport said material to its final destination. Safety-Kleen has the capacity and, where required, is permitted to accept, store and reclaim or process the materials described on the reverse side of this document.

Based on representations made by Customer regarding the type of material generated and the Customer's hazardous waste generation rate, Safety-Kleen may screen the materials for the presence of regulated hazardous wastes. In addition, at the time of collection Safety-Kleen may take and retain a sample of the material collected. Upon request, Safety-Kleen will provide Customer with a duplicate of this retain sample. Safety-Kleen's failure to screen Customer's material, or take a retain sample, in no way constitutes a waiver of Customer's obligation to properly classify his materials. Safety-Kleen relies on Customer's representations and Customer is responsible for informing Safety-Kleen of any process changes that may alter the characteristics of the materials provided.

III. Warranties and Indemnification

Customer warrants and represents that the materials provided hereunder are limited to Used Oils, Nonhazardous Wastes, and/or CESQG wastes as defined above. Customer further warrants and represents that no Nonconforming Wastes, have been provided to Safety-Kleen, and that the box checked in the Generator Status Section of this document accurately reflects the type of materials generated by Customer and Customer's hazardous waste status.

In the event that materials provided hereunder are found not to conform, or are suspected of not conforming, with the representations provided herein, Customer agrees to provide Safety-Kleen or its representatives access to Customer's tanks/containers which had stored the materials for the purpose of taking a sample of any remaining residuals. Upon request, Safety-Kleen will provide Customer with a duplicate of this sample.

In the event that any materials provided hereunder are found not to conform with representations provided herein, Safety-Kleen may, at its option and if allowed by law, return the materials, and all waste streams subsequently contaminated thereby, to Customer, or Safety-Kleen may cause such materials to be properly disposed of. Customer shall be responsible for all costs and expenses related to or arising from the proper management and disposal of Nonconforming Wastes, and the disposal of materials subsequently contaminated thereby.

Customer agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Safety-Kleen, its officers, directors, employees and agents from and against any and all losses, damages, penalties, demands, claims, judgments, or expenses of any kind related thereto, including without limitation all legal, remediation and disposal costs arising out of or relating to Customer's breach of these terms and conditions.

Safety-Kleen, its agents and contractors, have the capacity, and are authorized and permitted, in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations, to transport, accept, store, reclaim and/or dispose of the wastes listed on this document.

INVOICES REFLECTING CHARGES TO CUSTOMER ARE SUBJECT TO AN INTEREST RATE OF THE LESSER OF 1 1/2% PER MONTH (18% PER ANNUM) OR THE MAXIMUM RATE ALLOWED BY LAW ON ANY INVOICES THAT ARE NOT PAID WITHIN 30 DAYS. IN THE EVENT OF DEFAULT, SAFETY-KLEEN SHALL BE ENTITLED TO RECOVER COSTS OF COLLECTION, INCLUDING REASONABLE ATTORNEY'S FEES.

IN THE EVENT THE CREDIT CARD ISSUER REFUSES TO ACCEPT THE CREDIT CARD CHARGE FOR THIS TRANSACTION, CUSTOMER HEREBY AUTHORIZES SAFETY-KLEEN TO CHARGE THE AMOUNT OF THIS TRANSACTION TO CUSTOMER'S SAFETY-KLEEN ACCOUNT.
