The New Mexico Environmental Division (EID) has completed administrative review of the Part B application for the Farmington service center and found the application to be incomplete. The deficiencies to be addressed are described below and the regulations cited are from the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (HWMR-5, as amended 1989).

Specific Part B information requirements for tank systems.  
For the tank system that is to be permitted, provide details as required by HWMR-5, Part IX, 40 CFR section 270.16. An independent, professional engineer must review and certify the written assessment of the design and installation methods of the tank system.

Manifest System, Recordkeeping, and Reporting. Please address requirements listed under Pt. V, Subpart E, regarding the manifest system, recordkeeping, and reporting as they apply to Safety Kleen.

Please submit the requested information within 30 days of receipt of this letter. This information is needed before the application can be considered administratively complete and no permit can be issued unless the application is complete (Pt. IX, sec. 270.10(c)). Failure to send the information within 30 days will result in permit denial.
