
Dear Mr. Honker:


Pursuant to the Solid Waste Disposal Act, as amended by the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), as amended 42 U.S.C. 6901, et seq. NMSA 1978), a permit is issued to the Safety-Kleen Farmington Service Center (hereafter called the Permittee) to operate a hazardous waste container and tank storage facility at the location stated above.

The Permittee must comply with all the terms and conditions of this permit. This permit consists of the conditions contained herein including the attachments. Applicable provisions of regulations cited are those which are in effect on the effective date of this permit, New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (HWMR-6). This permit shall become effective upon the date of issuance in accordance with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act, Section 74-4-4.2 and shall run for a period of ten years.

This permit is also based on the assumption that all information contained in the permit application is accurate and that the facility will be operated as specified in the application. The permit application consists of information submitted in the original Part B permit application, dated September 14, 1987, and subsequent submissions received June 11, 1990, September 26, 1990 and in numerous exchanges of technical documents.

Any inaccuracies found in the information may be grounds for the termination or modification of this permit and potential enforcement action.
