Dear Mr. Czecholinski:

Pursuant to the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations, Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. submitted a permit application to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for the management of hazardous waste. The hazardous waste will be managed at the facilities known as Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. located in Albuquerque and Farmington, New Mexico.

Under the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act (HWA), Section 74-4-4.7 every applicant for a permit is required to file a disclosure statement with NMED providing the information required by, and on a form developed by NMED, in cooperation with the Department of Public Safety, at the same time the applicant files the application for a permit with the Secretary.

The Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. personal history disclosure forms submitted to NMED on November 12, 2001 were subsequently submitted to the New Mexico Department of Public Safety for preparation of an investigative report on the applicants. The enclosed disclosure statements include those of Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc., and other persons who will be, or could reasonably be expected to be, involved in hazardous waste management activities at Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc.

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The personal history disclosure form discrepancy list was submitted to Safety-Kleen by NMED, January 14, 2002, with a thirty (30) day deadline to correct those deficiencies and to forward the corrected disclosure forms to NMED for transmittal to the New Mexico Department of Public Safety.

A letter to NMED from Safety-Kleen addressed by Ms. Cindy Taylor was received by NMED on February 22, 2002, containing two corrected disclosure forms and informing NMED that the remaining outstanding forms would be forthcoming under separate cover.

Contact was made via telephone with Ms. Cindy Taylor, on April 4, 2002, regarding the remaining outstanding personal history disclosure forms. NMED was informed that she would check with the legal department of Safety-Kleen and inform NMED as to the status of the remaining disclosure forms. No information from Safety-Kleen has been received as of the date of this NOD.


Phone messages have been left with Ms. Taylor on April 26, 2002 and April 29, 2002 attempting to resolve the outstanding personal history disclosure form issue to no avail.

Safety-Kleen shall submit the required outstanding personal history disclosure forms for Kenneth Chalmers, John W. Rollings Jr., Robert Walter Luba, and Ronald A. Rittenmeyer, within thirty (30) calendar days from the date you receive this letter and the attached NOD. Failure to provide the required information within the designated time period may result in NMED issuing Safety-Kleen a notice of intent to deny (NOID) the Operating Permit renewal.

The New Mexico Environment Department may consider a petition for a deadline extension, provided that a written justification and the expected submittal time are given.
