Dear Mr. Dolk:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED, or the Department) has received the Safety-Kleen (SKFA or Permittee) "Final Closure Certification Report" summarizing the results of closure for the hazardous waste container storage units at 4210 A Hawkins Road, Farmington, New Mexico. The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Fee Regulations 20.4.2.201.G NMAC require assessment of fees from every owner or operator who submits a closure report for review, as set forth in Table 3 of 20.4.2.206 NMAC. NMED has attached an invoice to this letter. Payment of the fees is due within sixty (60) calendar days from the date that you receive the invoice.

If payment is by check, then you must provide the invoice number on the check. If payment is transmitted electronically, then you must submit a letter to Mr. Dave Cobrain, NMED Hazardous Waste Bureau, indicating the invoice number, payment amount, and the assessed activity prior to transferring funds. If the Permittee disagrees with the fee assessed, you may file an Administrative Appeal under the provisions of 20.4.2.302 NMAC. Upon receipt of the fees NMED will begin reviewing the closure report for compliance with the specifications in the approved closure plan and the applicable regulatory requirements.


Following review of the closure report and a verification inspection tour of the Facility by NMED staff, the Department will make a final determination on whether the Permittees' clean closure activities had addressed the regulatory requirements of the closure plan, sampling protocol and

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quality assurance requirements, as required by the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations at 40 CFR §264.111-115.
