The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED, the Department) Hazardous Waste Bureau (HWB) has reviewed Safety-Kleen Inc.'s Farmington Center (SKFA's, the Permittees') August 22, 2022, "*Final Closure Certification Report*" of Closure for the SKFA Hazardous Waste Container and Tank Storage Facility located at 4210A Hawkins Road, Farmington, New Mexico. The closure report was received by NMED on August 23, 2022.

Following NMED review of the closure report and a November 30, 2022 verification inspection tour of the Facility by HWB Compliance and Technical Assistance Program (CTAP) staff, NMED has determined that the clean closure activities, which the Permittees conducted, met the applicable regulatory requirements of the approved closure plan, sampling protocol, and quality assurance requirements, as required by the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations and 40 CFR §264.111-115.

NMED hereby approves clean closure of the Safety-Kleen Farmington hazardous waste Container and Tank Storage Facility effective the date you receive this letter. NMED also authorizes the Permittees to use the closed tanks for storage of nonhazardous used oil-related wastes, and the drum storage areas for 10-day waste transfer in accordance with the requirements specified in 40 CFR §279.45, "*Used Oil Storage at Transfer Facilities.*"

NMED will continue to inspect annually, those areas where nonhazardous used oil-related wastes will be stored as well as the 10-day transfer drum storage areas, pursuant to 40 CFR 262 and 279.45.

Since Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. plans to accept, store, and transfer used oil at the former Hazardous Waste Storage Facility in less than 90-day storage areas; while also generating and transferring hazardous waste, the Facility shall comply with all applicable requirements of "Standards Applicable to Generators of Hazardous Waste" specified in 40 CFR Part 262.
