RE: Request for Supplemental Information, OU 1307 RFI Report

As you are aware, the Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau has forwarded previously to you a Request for Supplemental Information (RSI)regarding Sandia National Laboratories' OU 1307 RFI Report. The RSI was discussed in a meeting with SNL staff on October 21, 1997, at Technical Area 3. As a result of this meeting, one item needed further clarification from us:

1. General Comment 2, Second Paragraph, Last Sentence -- SNL asked what was meant by "contamination extending as much as 85 ft below the surface".

Various metals and radionuclides were detected at concentrations or activities greater than approved background levels in surface and subsurface soils at ERSite 4 (LWDS Surface Impoundments). For example, concentrations of chromium exceed approved background levels at various depths ranging from 0-85 ft.

However, the main point of the second paragraph is that cross-sections and possibly other diagrams are needed showing the distributions of the various constituents of concern at each site.
