
The New Mexico EID letter dated February 21, 1989, designated you as the State contact for Environmental Restoration Program activities at our facility, the Sandia National Laboratories, Albuquerque (SNL). Accordingly, we are transmitting the "Statement of Work: Installation of Groundwater Monitoring Wells for RCRA Compliance Closure of the Mixed Waste Landfill."

The drilling activities are scheduled to begin on June 23, 1989 and will last for approximately six weeks. We are transmitting this document for your information and review. Due to the constraints of the drilling schedule, we are not able to offer you a lengthy review time period, but would appreciate any comments you may have on this work plan. Any comments you provide will be considered, and if possible, implemented into the work plan immediately. The State will be afforded the opportunity to participate in finalization of the Mixed Waste Landfill (MWL) Groundwater Monitoring Program.

We will provide you with copies of all future Environmental Restoration Activity work plans with at least 30 days for review and comments. We apologize for the delayed transmittal of this work plan.
