Dear Mr. Zamorski and Mr. Eagan:

The Permits Management Program of the New Mexico Environment Department's (NMED) Hazardous Waste Bureau (HWB) has reviewed the subject document. HWB personnel cannot adequately evaluate documents that are without properly constructed location maps and data tables. The NMED HWB requires that all sample data to be presented in summary tables (it is not necessary to include laboratory reports). Summary tables should include all sample identification numbers, analytical methods, approved background levels, units of measurement, sample depths, all analytes, results, detection limits and data qualifiers. All parameters should be included in the table even if there are no detections; please note that the HWB considers "J" coded analytical results to be "detections". Field and laboratory quality assurance and quality control (QA/QC) results including failures and data affected must also be discussed within the document. HWB suggests that Sandia Waste Management personnel consult with Sandia Environmental Restoration Project personnel on how to construct acceptable data tables.
