The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received your letter dated May 6, 2002, requesting extended storage of hazardous wastes at the Corrective Action Management Unit (CAMU). NMED hereby approves storage of RCRA hazardous wastes within the defined CAMU boundaries until July 30, 2003. RCRA wastes stored under this approval shall be stored in a manner compliant with all applicable regulations and conditions of the CAMU Permit. Storage approval for wastes regulated under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) must be granted by the U.S. EPA.
