The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the U. S. Department of Energy's May 21, 2010, request on behalf of itself and Sandia Corporation (collectively the Permittees) for a 30-day extension to submit the subject investigation report pertaining to the detection of toluene in groundwater samples from wells located at the Sandia National Laboratories Mixed Waste Landfill (MWL).
