Good afternoon Secretary Martin,

As you may know, public comments about the draft Long-Term Monitoring and Maintenance Plan (LTMMP)

for the Mixed Waste Landfill (MWL) at Sandia National Laboratories (SNL) are due today. Public comments about the draft SNL Hazardous Waste permit are due on Friday, November 16, 2012. Having both documents out for public comment places an unacceptable burden on the public to provide comments. Further the size of the documents, as well as the fact that all of the reference documents are not available, further impacts the ability of the public to provide informed comments.

Concerned Citizens for Nuclear Safety repeats the requests of Citizens for Alternatives to Radioactive Dumping, Citizen Action New Mexico and Robert H. Gilkeson for an extension of time to provide comments on both documents. We believe that a 90 day is extension for both is reasonable.

Because John Kieling, Chief of the Hazardous Waste Bureau, is out of the office, we have not received a definitive response from the New Mexico Environment Department. We respectfully request your intervention to make a determination. We look forward to your response. Thank you so much.
