As required by 40 CFR 270.11, the permit applications and reports will be signed for NTESS by one of the persons listed below.

- A Director responsible for environmental protection and/or waste management operations at the SNL facility in Albuquerque, New Mexico. This person meets the definition of a responsible corporate officer in 40 CFR 270.11(a)(1)(i).
- A duly authorized representative reporting to the Director responsible for environmental protection and/or waste management operations at the SNL facility in Albuquerque, New Mexico. This person meets the definition of a delegated manager in 40 CFR 270.11(b)(2).
