Dear Mr. Mico:

Enclosed is the Denial of Operating Permit and Termination of Interim Status for the above referenced facility. This action is in accordance with your March 13, 1985 decision to close the hazardous waste management units in lieu of seeking an operating permit. This notification constitutes a final permit decision under New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (HWMR-3), Section 303.

Upon the effective date specified in the enclosed Notice of Interim Status Termination, the facility active status under RCRA will change from an interim status treatment, storage, or disposal facility to a generator of hazardous wastes. As such you will be subject to all the generator requirements of RCRA and HWMR-3. This status change in no way affects the post-closure care requirements for the closed units for which your post-closure care permit application is pending. Sparton should continue to follow the post-closure care plan until the permit is issued.

In accordance with HWMR-3, Section 303, this action will become effective on the date specified in the enclosed Notice of Interim Status Termination, unless review is requested under HWMR-3, Section 303.G. If you wish to request review or a hearing, you must submit such request (an original and two copies) to the Environmental Improvement Board at the EID address above, within a thirty (30) day time period from receipt of this letter.
