1. The maximum number of people using said school or facility shall be as designated by school and Licensee agrees to adhere strictly to the occupancy limits of the area.
2. Licensee shall defend, save, hold harmless, and indemnify Licensor from any and all claims for the loss, damage or injury to any person or property from Licensee's use of the said school or facility.
3. Licensee shall be responsible for any and all loss, damage or injury that might be the result of Licensee's activities being conducted at said school or facility.
4. Licensee shall pay the charges upon receipt of invoice for Licensee's use of said school or facility which will be determined by the length of time it is required and including, but not limited to, the cost of the following: public address system, special lighting system, security, and any custodians.
5. LICENSEE SHALL NOT PAY ANY SCHOOL EMPLOYEE DIRECTLY. Licensor shall pay security, custodians and/or other personnel upon receipt of the principal's certification of additional hours worked, and Licensee shall thereafter reimburse Licensor for this cost.
6. School program needs will have priority over any outside usage of buildings.
