RE: Noncompliance of Order - Failure to Report Bi-weekly

Ground Water Level Measurements

Dear Mr. Mico:

As required under Administrative Order on Consent, U.S. EPA Docket No. VI-004(h)-87-H, Section IV.A.1.(a)i; the recovery wells and site monitoring wells shall be monitored on a minimum bi-weekly basis for peizometric levels. These bi-weekly measurements must be reported to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in the monthly report prepared by Sparton.

Under Section IV.A.1.(a)i of the Order, Sparton has failed to report the water level measurements to EPA for the following monitoring wells (MW): MW-34(0S), MW-35(0S), MW-36(0S) and MW-37(0S). Under Section IV.E.4. of the Order, Sparton must submit the bi-weekly ground water level measurements to EPA within fifteen (15) days of receipt of this notification of non-compliance.
