Sparton clean-up discussed by EPA

The New Mexico Environment Department, along with the United States Environmental Protection Agency, have scheduled joint informational meetings regarding the actions both agencies are taking toward Sparton Technology, Inc.

The meetings will take place from 2:30 to 4:30 p.m. and from 7 to 9 p.m. on Tuesday, Aug. 6

in the south conference room of Rio Rancho City Hall.

The discussions involve the Sparton facility located on North Coors Road.

The public meetings will focus on the groundwater clean-up programs both agencies are coordinating for Sparton. According to Bruce Swanton, of the environment department, groundwater near the facility

was contaminated about two years ago with methylene chloride. The clean-up process involves the evaporation of the contaminant by a process called 'air stripping.'

The program will include a briefing by officials of the environment department's Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau concerning the hazard-

ous waste permitting process and the contents of the permit to be issued to Sparton. EPA officials will present a briefing on the clean-up program underway at Sparton.

The informational meetings will not be conducted as a formal public meeting. The program will be identical at both meetings.
