Dear Concerned Citizen:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) and the United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 6 are holding joint informational meetings regarding the actions both agencies are taking at Sparton Technology, Inc. in Albuquerque. The meetings will take place from 2:30 to 4:30 pm and from 7:00 to 9:00 pm on August 6, 1991 in the south conference room of the city hall at 3900 Southern, Rio Rancho.

The public meetings will focus on the groundwater clean-up programs both agencies are coordinating at Sparton Technology, Inc. The event will not be a formal public hearing, but an informal informational meeting. The program will include a briefing by NMED staff concerning the hazardous waste permitting process and the contents of the permit to be issued to Sparton. Additionally, the USEPA-Region 6 staff will give a briefing on the clean-up program presently underway at Sparton. The program will be identical at both meetings.
