Dear Mr. Mico:

In response to the conversation of July 1, 1992, between Vincent Malott of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Jan Appel of Sparton Technology, the RCRA Facility Investigation (RFI) report of May 21, 1992 was amended by Sparton Technology. The amendments include the revision of page 63 of the RFI report and the deletion of pages 4-10 of Section II, Appendix 10. The revised/deleted section of the RFI report was conditionally approved in EPA's letter of June 26, 1992. EPA has completed its review and approves the RFI report as amended July 1, 1992.

Please submit the Report on the Effectiveness of the Ground Water Recovery Well System within 30 days from receipt of this letter. The report will need to include the references by Hvorslev (1951) and Scharadt (1971) for the supporting calculations.

In addition, the Draft Corrective Measures Study (CMS) report must be submitted within 120 days from receipt of this letter. The CMS report should also specifically address the high contaminant concentrations present in monitoring well MW-32.
