This letter is to address the requests of your July 8, 1993 letter and to confirm the July 13, 1993 telephone discussion between Mr. John Wakefield of Sparton Technology, Inc. (**ST**) and Ron Kern of the Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (**HRMB**). The topic of your letter and the telephone discussion was the Comprehensive Groundwater Monitoring Evaluation (**CME**) at ST which is now scheduled to begin on July 26, 1993.

The twelve monitoring wells (**MW**) which HRMB has selected for this CME include: MW-15, 32, 36, 41, 44, 53, 55, 56, 58, 60, 61, and 62. Analytical parameters will include: Volatile Organics (EPA Method 8240), and Total Metals (Antimony, Arsenic, Beryllium, Cadmium, Chromium, Copper, Lead, Mercury, Nickel, Selenium, Silver, Thallium, and Zinc; EPA Method 200 Series).


Through the July 13, 1993 telephone discussion, ST and HRMB agreed that regulatory personnel should be at your facility at 8:00 AM on July 26, 1993. Possible HRMB attendees for this CME include: Steve Alexander, Ronald Kern, and Jane Cramer. Person(s) from the Albuquerque District Office of the New Mexico Environment Department may also attend. Mr. Vincent Malott, EPA Region VI, may also come to observe the CME.
