Dear Mr. Alexander:

The second quarter, 1994 sampling event for the Alternate Ground Water Monitoring Program was conducted on April 6, 1994. Due to an oversight on my part I failed to notify NMED seven days in advance of our intention to conduct this sampling. Ron Kern was notified via telephone on April 7, 1994.

Monitoring Well MW-15 was not sampled at this time as the well was dry. We attempted to measure static water level with an airline and got 0" of water. Additionally the sample pump was removed and a sounder reading taken which confirmed the well was dry. We can attempt to sample this well later in the second quarter or wait until the third quarter sampling event. Please let me know how you would like us to proceed on this issue.
