Sparton Technology, Inc. notified your office via letter of our intention to commence groundwater sampling on October 3, 1994 for the Fourth Quarter Alternate Groundwater Monitoring Program. Subsequently we have learned that the EPA intends to conduct a split sampling event at the end of October. Therefore, Sparton requests a postponement of the October 3 sampling to coincide with EPA's sampling requirements. This would avoid duplicate sampling and analysis costs for AGMP wells that EPA might sample.
