RE: EPA Hazardous Waste Notifications

Dear Ms. Walker:

Enclosed are three Notification of Regulated Waste Activity Forms for Sparton Technology's Fortuna Road, Deming Electronics and Coors Road Facilities. Regarding the Fortuna Facility all hazardous waste activities ceased in the 4th Quarter 1993. The last shipment of hazardous waste left this facility on 10/20/93. Our lease for this facility expired 11/30/94.

The Notification for our Coors Road Facility is to change the generator status from Large Quantity Generator to Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator (<100 kg/month). This change is associated with a reduction and/or elimination of hazardous waste generating production activities at this facility. We anticipate a change to non-generator status in the near future when this facility is closed.

Deming Electronics is a Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator and this notification is being submitted as your records indicate a Large Quantity Generator status for this facility.
