This will confirm an extension until March 10, 1995 granted by the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) to Sparton Technology, Inc. (Sparton) for submittal of the proposal requested by NMED during a meeting with Jan Appel in November of 1994 and again in a letter to Sparton dated January 6, 1995. This is the second extension granted for this proposal which was originally due on February 17, 1995. NMED believes that the requested work should proceed as soon as possible in order to better address what is clearly a serious ground-water contamination problem. Therefore, NMED will not grant any further extensions.
