Dear Mr. Mico:

The Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) received your response on May 9, 1995, to our March 31, 1995, Notice of Deficiency for the Sparton Technologies, Inc. (ST) Post Closure Permit Application. You indicate in your response letter that some of the items needed for administrative completeness of the permit application deal with matters that are currently under review by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) pursuant to the Consent Order between ST and EPA dated October 1, 1988. Further, you state that you are unable to provide a time period for completing the application for those matters subject to the Consent Order.

This letter is to inform you that the ST Post Closure Permit Application remains deficient and subject to enforcement action to collect the requested information. We request that you keep the HRMB informed of your progress in reaching agreement with EPA regarding the information necessary to complete the application. The HRMB and other appropriate State Bureaus are coordinating with EPA to resolve all outstanding issues of concern.
