With reference to your request for the particular New Mexico regulations that would pertain to the ongoing investigations and cleanup of contaminants in environmental media at the Sparton Technology, Inc. facility (9621 Coors Road NW in Albuquerque), the following state regulations must be addressed:

- 1) The regulatory citation for the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) for which the State of New Mexico has authority:

Title 20, Chapter 4, Part 1, New Mexico Administrative Code (20 NMAC 4.1), which incorporates Title 40, Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Parts 260 through 270.

- 2) The regulatory citation for the New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission (WQCC):

New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission Regulations, Parts 1-203 and 3-103 (effective November 18, 1993).
