At the request of Rob Pine with the New Mexico Environment Department, Groundwater Protection Bureau, Sparton Technology, Inc. and NMED will conduct a groundwater split sampling event. Sampling will commence on January 8, 1995 and involve all 45 monitoring wells. To date the parameters selected by NMED are EPA Method 601/602 and Total Chromium. Sampling for the Alternate Groundwater Monitoring Program will be conducted by STI during the split sampling event.
