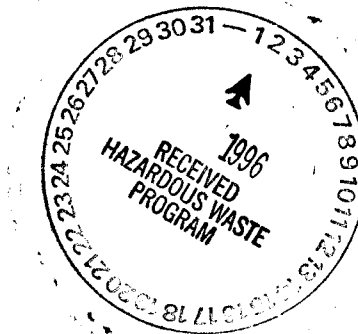

We anticipate that this report will be completed by March 15, 1996. The delay is due to several factors, 1: competing report requirements specifically the Annual Groundwater Report also due at NMED on March 1, 1996, 2: the need to modify our 1993 Biennial Hazardous Waste Report to include remediated groundwater activities and 3, substantial hazardous waste labpacking activities conducted in 1994.
