Enclosed are 5 copies of ATI Lab Reports for the 1st Quarter 1996 STI-NMED Sampling Event conducted from 1-8-96 to 1-17-96. ATI lab report numbers are: 601321, 601338, 601346, 601351 and 601356. The only monitor wells which did not provide adequate water for a sample were: MW-15, 50 and 54. MW-17 did not produce enough water for a total chromium sample.

Additionally we have provided an updated copy of the Supplementary Ground Water Monitoring Program Data Table. The data includes all analysis conducted on these wells from installation to the present.
