Dear Mr. Kern:

As discussed via telephone on April 4, 1996 Sparton Technology, Inc. intends to commence ground water sampling on April 22, 1996. The standard protocol would be to sample SGMP wells, (MW-32, 36, 37, 42, 43, 46, 48, 51, 53, 55, 56, 57, 58, 60, 61 and 64) for EPA Method 8240 and then AGMP wells, (MW-9, 14, 15, 16, 19, 20, 21 and 22) for Method 8010, pH, specific conductance, TOC and TOX. As of April 16, 1996 Vince Malott of EPA Region VI has informed us that he will take split samples during this event. Once Mr. Malott has selected the wells and parameters to be tested we will notify you.
