RE: **Statement of Basis, Sparton Technology, Inc. - Coors Road Facility, Albuquerque, New Mexico**

With reference to our discussion on the above date, I am enclosing a copy of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Statement of Basis for Corrective Action at the Sparton Technology (ST) site. The Statement of Basis is a public document and includes a summary of site-specific information regarding contaminants of concern and the nature of the groundwater contaminant plume. Based upon current information, the groundwater contamination has moved in a northwesterly direction from ST and has proceeded beneath Irving Blvd.

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) appreciates your concerns as a real estate developer in the vicinity of the ST contamination.
