

Dear Mr. McQuillan:

On behalf of Sparton Technology, Inc., we wish to notify you, as per Section II.E. of the "Work Plan for Installation of Additional Wells and Conducting A Pump Test in the Area of the leading Edge of the Contaminant Plume Originating from the Sparton Technology, Inc. Coors Road Facility", which requires that Sparton shall give Plaintiffs at least three days notice of all planned sampling events and shall make provisions for Plaintiffs to obtain splits of all samples collected, that we will collect groundwater samples from monitoring well MW-71, observation wells OB-1 and OB-2, and test well CW-1 on Tuesday, September 1, 1998. MW-71 will be equipped with a dedicated bladder pump, and OB-1, OB-2 and CW-1 will be equipped with temporary electric submersible pumps for purposes of purging and sample pumping. Each well will be purged of three casing volumes prior to sampling.

The following analyses will be performed on the samples collected from each well:

Alkalinity	310.1
Hardness	130.1 & 130.2
