Dear Mr. Mico:

The Hazardous Waste Bureau (HWB) of the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed the Revised Post-Closure Permit Application submitted to the HWB on September 5, 2000. HWB has made a determination that the document is administratively complete.

Corrective action requirements specified under 40 CFR Part 264, Subpart F, are being implemented under Consent Decree CIV 97 0206 LH/JHG and will not be included in the Post-Closure Permit Application.

The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Fee Regulations 20 NMAC 4.2 require assessment of fees when administrative review of a document is complete. HWB will issue an invoice to you under a separate letter. Payment is due within sixty (60) calendar days from the date that you receive the invoice under the provisions of 20 NMAC 4.2.301.2. Per an existing agreement, the assessed fee is for Post-Closure Care Permitting w/o Corrective Action.

Should you need to request an extension of the sixty-day period the request must be received by the New Mexico Environment Department a minimum of fourteen (14) calendar days prior to the end of the sixty-day period. Should you disagree with the fee assessed you may file an Administrative Appeal under the provisions of 20 NMAC 4.2.302.1.


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Upon receipt of the fees, NMED will begin review of the document for technical adequacy pursuant to 20 NMAC 4.2.301.2 and 3.
