
The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed the April 5, 2001 letter proposing the relocation of the security fence along the northern edge of the surface impoundment. The relocation of the security fence will facilitate the construction of an access road around the Melloy Dodge (Sparton Technology, Inc) facility.

NMED hereby grants approval to move the security fence as requested in the April 5, 2001 letter. The north edge of the security fence will be moved approximately nine (9) feet south to vapor recovery well VR-2. VR-2 will be located south of the security fence. The existing asphalt drainage swale to the north of the surface impoundments will not be disturbed. Approximately seven (7) post holes will be drilled in the existing asphalt cover along the new fence alignment. The drilled holes will be in an area which will not directly impact the existing surface impoundments.
