Attached you will find a draft settlement agreement for your review. The Hazardous Waste Bureau ("Bureau") provides this draft agreement to further settlement discussion and facilitate a timely resolution of this case.

As we discussed, this settlement agreement reflects the consolidation of the two land disposal units at the Sparton Facility and removal of the new drum storage area. The Bureau is also offering to waive late charges and billing fees on the unpaid amounts.

I anticipate that you would like some time to review this draft agreement. Pursuant to our verbal agreement, the deadline for filing findings and conclusions in this case was extended to December 11, 2001. The Bureau proposes that we further extend this deadline until December 18, 2001 to allow adequate time to explore settlement.
