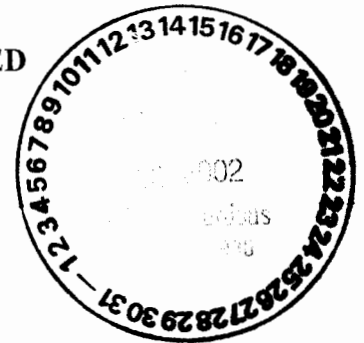

Pursuant to Water Quality Control Commission (WQCC) Regulation 20.6.2.3109, the application for amendment for DP-1184, submitted by Gary Richardson of Metric Corp. on your behalf is hereby approved, subject to the condition listed below. The discharge plan was approved on June 26, 1998. The facility is located in northwest Albuquerque in projected Section 7, T11N, R3E, Bernalillo County. In approving this discharge plan amendment, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has determined that the requirements of WQCC Regulation 20.6.2.3109.C have been met.

However, approval of this amendment to your discharge plan does not relieve you of your responsibility to comply with any other conditions or requirements of the approved discharge plan, DP-1184, or any other applicable federal, state, and/or local laws and regulations, such as zoning requirements and nuisance ordinances.

CONDITION FOR APPROVAL

All references to EPA Method 8021 in the approved discharge plan dated June 26, 1998 shall be replaced by EPA Method 8260.

Please be advised that approval of this discharge plan amendment does not relieve Sparton Technology Inc. of liability should your operation result in actual pollution of surface or ground water which may be actionable under other laws and/or regulations.


