Dear Mr. Stranko:

The Hazardous Waste Bureau (HWB) of the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed the Draft Source Containment System Operation and Maintenance Manual submitted to the HWB on January 31, 2002. HWB has made a determination that additional information is required prior to granting approval of the above referenced document pursuant to Section X, Paragraph 27, of the Consent Decree.

Please respond to this request within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter. The requested information should be included in the Final Source Containment System Operation and Maintenance Manual to be submitted for approval to HWB.

Please supply the following information.

- 1) Containment System Description, Page 1 – A 3-hp submersible pump is mentioned as being installed in CW-2, whereas the referenced drawings, Figures 2 and 3, do not show the installed pump.

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- 2) Attachment B, Drawing E-1 – The electrical plan is entitled “Sparton Stripper Building, Benton Street NW”. Please correct the address to refer to 9621 Coors Road NW.
- 3) Attachment B – Please include the Certificate of Occupancy for the Source Containment System Air Stripper building.
- 4) Attachment K – The names, addresses, and phone numbers (work and home) of all persons qualified to act as emergency coordinator shall be included in the Site Health and Safety Plan pursuant to 20.4.1.500 NMAC (incorporating 40 CFR 264.52 (d)).
- 5) Attachment K, Page 23 – An evacuation route is mentioned in the third paragraph, but there appears to be no evacuation route shown in the Site Health and Safety Plan. Please include the evacuation route as required by 20.4.1.500 NMAC (incorporating 40 CFR 264.52 (f)).
- 6) Attachment K – A copy of the Site Safety and Health Plan shall be submitted to all local police departments, fire departments, hospitals, and emergency response teams that may be required to provide emergency services in accordance with 20.4.1.500 NMAC (incorporating 40 CFR 264.53 (b)).
- 7) Attachment K – Additional emergency procedures pursuant to 20.4.1.500 NMAC (incorporating 40 CFR 264.56 (d), and (f) through (j)) should be addressed in the Site Health and Safety Plan.
