The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has completed the Final Annual Audit for calendar year 2001 for your facility. Should your facility find it necessary to appeal the Annual Fee invoice under the provisions of 20.4.2.302 NMAC the appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days of the date of the invoice accompanying this letter. Any appeal of the HWMBF invoice must be filed in writing and accompanied by a copy of the invoice being contested and state the grounds upon which the appellant disagrees with the assessment.
